El viaje también le llevará a lugares como Explora El Chaltén, a los pies del monte Fitz Roy, en la agreste Patagonia; Tierra Atacama, en el desierto más árido del mundo, y a la isla de Pascua, vigilada desde tiempos inmemoriales por las poderosas esculturas de piedra de los moáis. En Perú, caminará tras las huellas de los incas por el Valle Sagrado, en el que se encuentra la ciudad en ruinas de Machu Picchu, y en Ecuador, durante una estancia en Kapawi Ecolodge, podrá conocer a los indígenas achuar. El viaje también pasa por Colombia, concretamente por la Casa Pombo, una elegante casona situada en Cartagena de Indias y casi tan antigua como la que tal vez sea la más bella ciudad colonial de América Latina. En Costa Rica, tres amigos cumplieron su sueño abriendo el Nantipa, el hotel de playa ideal; y en Nicaragua, unos hermanos estadounidenses encontraron su paraíso en la isla privada isleta El Espino. Por supuesto, no se puede olvidar México. Entre otros destacan el espectacular hotel Terrestre de Alberto Kalach en Puerto Escondido; el ecléctico Mesón Hidalgo, que combina un bed & breakfast y boutiques en San Miguel de Allende, o el desenfadadamente lujoso Hotel San Cristóbal Baja en Todos Santos.

The discovery of and excavations at Pompeii in the second half of the eighteenth century not only provided historians with a trove of information about ancient Roman civilization but also fired artists' imaginations and inaugurated the vogue for the "Pompeian style" that so influenced the West in the nineteenth century. This book reproduces, along with commentary, *Le case i monumenti di Pompeii* (1854) of Fausto and Felice Niccolini, the first work to present completely and systematically all the public and private buildings so far excavated in Pompeii. wondrous watercolors the Niccolinis created to document Pompeii and is thus a beautiful and essential tool in understanding the excavated remains themselves and how the modern archaeologists perceived and recorded the ancient world. These magnificently reproduced drawings of the excavations are accompanied by texts that explain the documents by the Niccolinis, as well as the evolution of the Pompeian style in Europe, the pictorial representation of Pompeii in the nineteenth century from engravings to photographs, and the evolving styles of archaeological documentation.
